# Farewell 2018

We cannot stress enough the value of these vouchers as they are the equivalent of a purchase order and parents are asked to keep them in a safe place as there will be no replacement of these.

***All students will need to be in Champion Bay Senior High School uniform for Day 1 of 2019.***

Expression of interest meetings were conducted by Waneen Bennett and Neil Wyatt during Week 8.

All staff and students will belong to one of four factions for competition. We will attempt to group families together in the same faction. A Faction Coordinator will be appointed once these factions have been named. This person will be responsible for disseminating information to staff and students and ensuring places are filled on race days!

### **Champion Bay Senior High School P&C**

In September 2018, at a General Meeting of the John Willcock College and Geraldton Senior College Combined P&C a motion was passed to change the registration of that body to the Geraldton Senior High School P&C from 1 January 2019. It was decided that Champion Bay Senior High School would create a new P&C from 1 January 2019.

On Tuesday 9 October, a meeting was held to determine if there were enough parents and community members to create a new P&C for CBSHS. There were and it was decided at that meeting to hold a first P&C meeting on Wednesday 21 October to create the motions required to register the group with Western Australian Council of State School Organisations (WACSSO).

A major issue for discussion has been the provision of a P&C conducted cafeteria.

As the Combined P&C is the employer of all canteen staff at both sites and not the school, this has had impact on the canteen staff at John Willcock College.

After seeking legal advice and information from WACSSO, it is clear that this new P&C is not in a position financially to take over the running of the canteen. P&C Associations are not able to trade if they are not financial – that is, they may only purchase stock equivalent to cash reserves. At present, this beginning association has only the membership fees of the 23 members being held. The body does not yet have a bank account, is not registered for GST and general tax purposes and remains unincorporated until the registration process is complete.

The school has made a decision to lease the premises to a third party who will pay to use the premises. They will provide a service to the students and staff at the school and will use the premises to conduct their business after their obligations to the school are discharged daily. The lease payments will be transferred to the P&C to allow them to get up and running financially.

At a meeting held on Thursday 6 December, the new P&C has identified a number of fund raising initiatives to commence in the New Year. They are looking at funding an adventure playground as a major long term goal. This will be of enormous benefit to our students!

**The P&C will be meeting on Tuesday 19 February at 6:30pm in the Staffroom at the school – please come and join us!**

### **Special Events**

#### **Visit by Deputy Director General Stephen Baxter**

Deputy Director General Stephen Baxter visited the school on Friday 30 November. He is most well-known to us as our former Regional Executive Director and he knows the school context well. He was most ably shown around by student councillors Brooke Martin and Jack Garland. The tour included the Administration space, cafeteria, Music and Dance Centre and the Technologies space. As is the practice, fences around the Admin had miraculously disappeared overnight on Thursday to allow for an uninterrupted view of the space between the new buildings, which looks very open and modern. His visit also allowed the APs and I to speak with him in the Conference Room, where I sought some clarification around the title of the STEM program. In the Minister's original statement, it was said the new school would have a specialist program. Mr Baxter confirmed that this would be an Approved Specialist Program beginning in 2020 - with student selections taking place in 2019. The funding for a Program Coordinator would commence in 2019 and run for three years. This is an enormous boost to CBSHS.

#### **Celebration Assembly Thursday 6 December held at Sun City Christian Centre**

In an attempt to create a new precedent, we undertook a trial idea, having a split assembly for Semester 2. The Year 7/8 had the first assembly in blocks 1 and 2 followed by the Presentation Assembly for Year 9 in Blocks 3 and 4.

The reasons for trialling this model has been brought about by the fact that we do not have a venue at school that is large enough to seat the whole school. It is inappropriate for students to have to sit on the wooden floor for 2 hours, especially as we move into senior school.

The venue we used was the Sun City Christian Centre main auditorium that has fixed seating and great sound. There is parking for parents and it is a short stroll from the school.

Although there were some small issues we had not considered, the trial was an overwhelming success. Students were unanimous in their approval of the seating and the sound. Overall, the assembly was professionally presented and fitted with the notion of older students.

We will be investigating further use of this space in 2019.

### **School Development Day focus 2019**

Day 1 to be held on Thursday 31 January 2019. The AIEOs along with Helen Bell have taken this day in hand. After a discussion with Principal Consultant Kevin O'Keefe on Day 1 of this term, they have planned workshops to increase the capacity of teachers to explicitly use their knowledge of the history, culture and experiences of Aboriginal people within classroom practice (Focus 2019 – High Quality Teaching).

At this stage, Day 2 will work around team building within the new learning teams and curriculum.

### **Year 6 Transition**

This program was held over 3 days from the 19-21 November and was a huge success. Feedback from the students has been awesome. Students were treated to a 'taster' of all learning areas and some fun with the Student Services Team.

We invited all parents to start Monday morning with a 'beverage and muffin' available from the cafeteria. We conducted a Parent Information evening on Monday 19 November in the Dance Studio and had a strong attendance of new parents. Speakers were from all Learning Areas, Student Services, Library and Admin. On Wednesday morning we held a Parent Morning tea in the cafeteria followed by a tour taken by Danielle Wilton. On Wednesday evening we held the first Champion Bay SHS P&C and passed the motions necessary to commence registration with WACSSO. There were a number of new parents attending and this was great to see.

### **Year 10 Transition**

This day was held on Monday 19 October in conjunction with the Orientation day held at GSC for Year 10 students. We tried a new format for this day, using the day as a series of information sessions for senior students. Very successfully undertaken was the 'CBSHS Big Ideas' session that aimed to find out what students really think about a number of issues.

Feedback from both programs is appended to this report.

### **Attendance**

Given the data appended to this report, it is particularly pleasing that across 2 of our 3 targets for 2018, we are in front of the targets. i.e. unexplained absences and regular attendance! Our overall attendance rate has slipped just below the target, as it has for the past few years. Strategies in place to address this include an ongoing focus on all Form teachers calling home to see where students are and explicit teaching of attendance figures in Form classes.

### **STEM – Lego League**

Once again, the College team has performed significantly well in this competition. STEM Coordinator Hollie Roberts described the performance of the team as really solid and this performance was enhanced by the introduction of Robotics as an option in 2018. Apart from a glitch in the table setting that prevented an even surface for robots to perform on, the team finished well in the rankings and this is commendable when it is considered that the oldest students in the team are still one year younger than most of the members of the other teams. We will keep most of this team as Year 10 students, so we look forward to 2019.

## Commissioner for Children and Young People Colin Pettit is inviting young people with experience of adoption to share their views on proposed changes to the state's adoption legislation.

Commissioner Pettit said that the recent statutory review of the *Adoption Act 1994* had recommended changes to the Act.

"There are 31 recommendations from the recent review and I would like to ensure children and young people with experience of adoption have the opportunity to provide comment on these recommendations and how they should be implemented," Mr Pettit said.

"These recommendations include changes around determining the best interests and wellbeing of a child, mandatory counselling for children required to consent to their adoption and for birth parents under 16 years of age considering adoption for their child, how sibling relationships are maintained and review of adoption plans.

"Children and young people who have been adopted will have an opportunity to confidentially share their views on how they were adopted, the level of involvement they had in decisions and anything else they want the Commissioner to know about their adoption experience.

"Adoption has a profound impact on a child's wellbeing and all children and young people have the right to be heard on decisions that affect them."

Mr Pettit said that this would be the **first specific consultation** held with children and young people on adoption in WA.

There are three categories of adoption in WA – intercountry adoptions of children from overseas, local adoptions of children from within Australia and 'known' adoptions, including adoptions by step-parents, other relatives and carers.

In 2016-17 there were 44 adoptions orders made in WA involving 27 children and 17 orders for young people over the age of 18 years. Of the 44 adoptions, 28 were known adoptions, five were local and 11 were intercountry adoptions.

Young people's views from this consultation will be provided to the Department of Communities and the Minister for Child Protection.

Young people aged 12 to 25 can share their views confidentially in a range of ways, by participating in an interview, completing an online survey or being part of a focus group discussion. ### When and where will the uniforms be available?

Uniforms will be available from Total Uniforms at 2 Jensen St, Geraldton, from 2 of January 2019 and beyond. Layby orders can be made from 19 November 2018.

### How do the uniform vouchers work?

Each continuing enrolled student entering Years 8, 9 and 10 will be allocated one voucher for a Senior or Middle School Uniform Package. The package includes three polo shirts, two pairs of shorts or skorts, one jacket and one pair of school track pants.

A Parent or Guardian will be required to collect and sign for the voucher at the school Administration Office. Please treat the voucher like cash as we can only provide one voucher for each student. The school will take no responsibility for any loss of vouchers. Take your voucher to Total Uniforms to exchange for appropriate sized clothing. At this time the Parent or Guardian will be required to sign again to collect uniforms.

### Can I purchase additional items?

Yes, additional items will be available to purchase. Please see the attached price list.

### Is the new uniform compulsory for the beginning of 2019?

Yes, we are very excited to be starting the year with a new school name and a new uniform. As uniform packages are provided for existing students, they will be required to wear the new uniform from the first school day of 2019.

### Currently students can wear any pants or shorts in the appropriate colour, is that still the case?

No, from 2019 we are moving to compulsory track pants, shorts or skorts with the school name. This will give our students a unified appearance.

### Are there boys and girls uniforms?

Students can choose any of the three styles of summer pants. A microfiber short (in a choice of two lengths), stretch polyester skort and girls sport style short.

### My child will change schools after 2019 will they receive another uniform package?

### Can I use the voucher to purchase uniform items other than listed in the package?

### What happens if I lose my voucher?

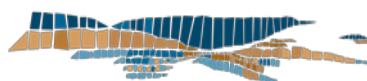

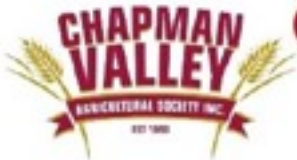
