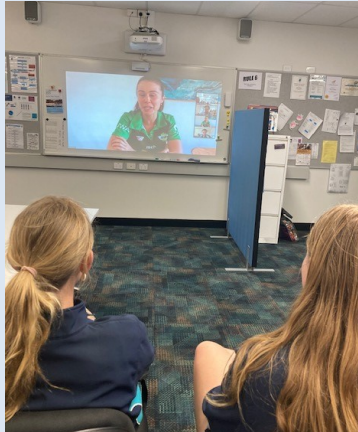


## West Coast Fever Presentation
