<p>A voluntary payment requested from parents towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by students in the educational program. Each secondary school in WA can request a contribution of \$235 per student per year in Years 7 to 10.</p> <p>Parents are asked to pay the contribution towards the cost of providing an education program that meets the requirements of the WA Curriculum. It may include the hire of textbooks and provision of text materials, course materials etc.</p> <p>This contribution is voluntary; however, the government has stated that parents who can afford to do so are expected and encouraged to pay the contribution costs.</p>
